

Art Camp and Summer Art Study 2013 Adult and Teen Volunteer Opportunities

In summer 2013, the Modern will offer its popular Art Camp at the Modern for ages 4–17. This special program includes hands-on art workshops and gallery discussions led by prominent local artists. The entire experience is fueled by the energetic dedication of volunteers who fulfill roles of camp counselor, artist's assistant, and camp assistant. In preparation for their duties, volunteers learn about the permanent collection, as well as develop a special relationship with campers, artists, and museum staff. Responsibilities include helping counselors with children's group activities, assisting during art classes, helping artists prepare materials, snack set-up, and various jobs throughout the week.

These positions require a commitment to either the entire ten-week season or to two-week sessions that include a preparation week (9 am-noon, Monday through Friday) followed by a week of camp (8 am-4 pm, Monday through Friday, though times may vary from camp to camp). This year we have added a second session to the camp for 5 to 8 year olds. Volunteers interested in this camp must be available for three consecutive weeks. Art Camp and Summer Art Study volunteer opportunities are open to mature and serious students ages 17 and up with an interest in art and mentoring to young children. An informal interview and mandatory meeting are required.
