Docent-Guided Tours

Student groups are invited to the Modern for FREE docent-guided tours throughout the year. Docent tours are a great way to introduce your students to modern and contemporary art while learning about the context, technique, and process of works on view.

- Docent-guided tours last approximately one hour.
- Tours are available for groups of 10 to 60 per hour.
- One chaperone is required for every 15 students.
- Teachers and chaperones are required to stay with their group at all times.
- Please plan to arrive 10 minutes early to allow time to unload and divide into groups. If you are running late, please let us know!
